## STUDENTS MAY AWARE....

### 1) RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT, 2005 :-

The Right to Information Act, 2005 (22 of 2005) has been enacted by the Parliament and has come into force from 15 June, 2005. This Act provides for right to information for citizens to secure access to information under the control of public authorities in order to promote transparency and accountability in the working of every public authority. All Universities and Colleges established by law made by Parliament or by State Legislature or by notification by the appropriate Government or owned, controlled or substantially financed directly or indirectly by funds provided by the Government shall come within the meaning of a Public Authority under this Act. ### 2) ANTI RAGGING COMMITTEE :-

Anti Ragging Committee of University of Mumbai under the UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009 (under section 26 (I)(g) of the University Grants Commissions Act 1956) is actively working in this college.

### 3) WOMEN DEVELOPMENT CELL (WDC) :-

As per the Vice-Chancellors directions No.WDC/VCD/240 of 2008, issued under section 14(8) of the Maharashtra University Act 1994 the Women Development Cell of University of Mumbai has been constituted in this college in every academic year.

### 4) STUDENT SPECIAL CELL :-

It works to circulate Government of India and Commission's decisions and to collect regularly, on an annual basis information regarding course-wise admissions to candidates belonging to the Scheduled Casts and Scheduled Tribes in the Universities and Colleges for different courses, in forms prescribed, by a Stipulated date, and to take follow up action, where required. It monitor the working of the remedial coaching scheme. It function as a Grievances Readressal Cell for the Grievances of SC/ST students and employees and render them necessary help in solving their academic as well as administrative problems. It maintain a register for employment of SCs/STs in the University and Colleges for the candidates belonging to SC/ST communities for various posts in the university/colleges.

## RULES AND REGULATION FOR 'UNFAIR MEANS'

### University of Mumbai Ordinance 5050

"Unfair means" includes one or more of the following acts or omissions on the part of student/ s during the examination period,

- i. Possessing unfair means material and or copying there from.
- ii. Transcribing any unauthorised material or any other use thereof.



- iii. Intimidating or using obscene language or threatening or use of violence against invigilator or person on duty for the conduct of examination or manhandling him/her or leaving the examination hall without permission of the supervisor or causing disturbances in any manner in the examination proceedings.
- iv. Communicating with other examinees or anyone else inside or outside the examination hall.
- v. Mutual / Mass copying.
- vi. Smuggling-put, either blank or written, or smuggling in of answerbooks as copying material.
- vii. Smuggling-in blank or written answerbook' and forging signature of the Jr. Supervisor thereon.
- viii. Interfering with or counterfeiting of University/Collage/Institution seal, or answer books or office stationary used in the examinations.
- ix. Insertion of currency notes in the answerbooks or attempting to bribe any of the persons connected with conduct of examinations.
- x. Impersonation at the University/College/Institution examination.
- xi. Revealing identity in any form in the answer written or in any other part of the answerbook by the student at the University or College or Institution examination.
- xii. Or any other similar act/s and/or omission/s which may be considered as unfair means by the competent authority.

## UGC REGULATIONS ON CURBING THE MENACE OF RAGGING IN HIGHER EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION; 2009

(Under Section 26(1) (9) of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956)

E.1-16/2007 (CPP-II) dated 17th June , 2009.

### **Preamble -**

To provide the healthy developments physically and psychologically, of all students in all higher education institutions, the University Grants Commission, brings forth this regulation.

### **1. Title commencement and applicability :-**

These regulations shall be called the "UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009.

They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the official Gazette.

They shall apply to all the institutions coming within the definition of an University under subsection (f) of section (2) of the UGC, 1956.

### **2. Objectives :-**

To prohibit any conduct by any student/s which causes annoyance, hardship or psychological harm, fear or apprehension to fresher or other student/s.

### **3. What constitutes Ragging :-**

- a) Teasing, treating or handling by words spoken or written or an act.
- b) Rowdy or indisciplined activities.
- c) Asking to do any act which generates as sense of shame.
- d) Any act of physical abuse, sexual abuse etc.

### **4. Measures for prohibition of ragging at the institutional level :-**

All institutions shall take all necessary and required measures to achieve the objective of eliminating ragging, within the institution or outside.

### **5. Measures for prevention of ragging at the institution level :-**

- a) Public declaration that ragging is totally prohibited in the institution.
- b) Prospectus shall prominently print these regulations in full.
- c) Affidavit to sign by every applicant that he/she would not indulge in the ragging.
- d) Social behavioural pattern of applicant should be checked through L.C./T.C./Migration at the time of admission.
- e) Each institution shall tighten security, anti-ragging committee formation etc.
- f) Each institution shall give adequate publicity in institute in mass by mass media about law prohibiting ragging and the negative aspects of ragging.

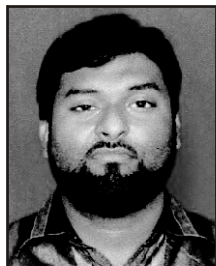

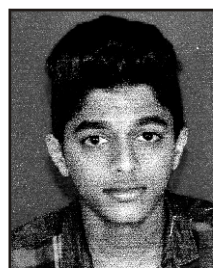
