The college was established in 2009-10. It was for General Science. In 2011-12 college expanded with graduation in Computer Science. From the academic year 2021-22 this college started post graduation courses i.e M.Sc Chemistry and M.Sc Botany. In the academic year 2022-23 this college started Bachelor in Commerce (Accounting in Finance) & Bachelor of Management studies (BMS). From A.Y. 2024-25, research centre in chemistry will start.

At present it is only Degree College in Science in Murud Taluka. It underwent assessment and Re-Accreditation by NAAC in academic year 2024-25 with B+ Grade and 2.69 CGPA. This College received Best College Award from Kokan Alpasankhyank Wihar Manch, Raigad. In A.Y. 2023-24, this institute received appreciation award for NSS unit by University of Mumbai. Also received appreciation award by District collector, Raigad for Electoral awareness campaign.

राष्ट्रीय शिक्षण धोरण २०२० (एनईपी २०२०) बदल

The Vision and Essence of National Education Policy 2020 (NEP 2020)

The National Education Policy 2020 (NEP 2020) is a landmark reform in the Indian education system, introduced to cater to the evolving demands of the 21st-century learner. It envisions an education system that is rooted in Indian ethos, yet globally aligned, aiming to nurture thoughtful, creative, and innovative individuals who are capable of contributing meaningfully to society. This visionary policy emphasizes the development of a holistic, flexible, multidisciplinary, and learner-centered educational framework that ensures equity, excellence, and inclusivity. By restructuring the curriculum and pedagogy across all levels, NEP 2020 fosters the integration of vocational education, critical thinking, and value-based learning with a strong emphasis on conceptual understanding and practical application.

The policy aims to overhaul the traditional rigid education system and instead introduces flexible pathways for learning, personalized curricula, and multiple exit and re-entry options. It encourages psychological, sociological, and physiological development of students, thus emphasizing not just academic excellence but also emotional and ethical maturity. NEP 2020 proposes to bridge the gap between formal education and real-life skills, enabling learners to become responsible citizens and global professionals. It strongly advocates blending modern pedagogy with traditional Indian knowledge systems and value-based education to instill cultural pride and a sense of rootedness in Indian heritage.

The Vision of National Education Policy: The National Education Policy 2020 (NEP 2020) has been formulated and adopted to meet the needs of 21st-century learners. It aims to create a holistic, inclusive, and multidisciplinary education system that prepares individuals for global competency, lifelong learning, and innovation. NEP seeks to revolutionize the current education structure by introducing flexibility in learning pathways, skill-based education, and promotion of Physiological, Sociological, and Psychological development.

The NEP 2020 aims to:

- Transform the education system by integrating Indian traditional knowledge systems with modern education.
- Promote a multidisciplinary and holistic education that ensures the unity and integrity of all knowledge.
- Encourage critical thinking, creativity, and innovation.
- Enhance the capacity of learners to apply knowledge to real-life situations.
- Promote ethical, rational, and compassionate behavior.
- Provide flexibility in subject choice, course design, and assessment patterns.
- Encourage learning that is rooted in Indian culture and values.
- Improve research and development through enhanced quality and relevance.
- Ensure inclusion and equity in education.

Key Objectives of NEP 2020

- Integration of Traditional and Modern Knowledge: The policy aims to merge the richness of India's traditional knowledge systems—spanning Ayurveda, Yoga, Mathematics,



- Astronomy, and more—with modern scientific advancements, ensuring that students benefit from both ancient wisdom and contemporary relevance.
- **Multidisciplinary and Holistic Education:** It promotes an education model that allows learners to study a combination of arts, sciences, commerce, and vocational subjects, thus dismantling the silos of discipline-specific learning and nurturing intellectual versatility.
 - **Critical Thinking and Creativity:** The focus is on moving beyond rote learning to encourage higher-order thinking, innovation, and analytical abilities that prepare students to navigate complex problems and dynamic work environments.
 - **Application of Knowledge:** Learners are encouraged to apply their knowledge in real-life scenarios through experiential learning models, projects, internships, and community engagements.
 - **Ethical and Compassionate Behavior:** The policy emphasizes moral education, character development, empathy, respect for others, and environmental consciousness to shape well-rounded individuals.
 - **Flexible Learning System:** A flexible curriculum with a wide array of subject choices and assessment formats allows students to tailor their learning pathways in alignment with their interests and goals.
 - **Cultural and National Identity:** NEP 2020 encourages education rooted in Indian languages, culture, and values, thereby strengthening students' sense of identity and connection with their heritage.
 - **Research and Development:** By enhancing research infrastructure and promoting inquiry-based learning, the policy aims to elevate the quality and impact of Indian research globally.
 - **Equity and Inclusion:** The policy ensures that marginalized and underrepresented communities are given ample support to access quality education, thus bridging socio-economic and gender-based disparities.

Programme Design and Credit Framework: The academic programmes are meticulously structured in alignment with the NEP 2020 guidelines and the National Higher Education Qualifications Framework (NHEQF) prescribed by the University Grants Commission (UGC). The curriculum is designed to provide a balance between theoretical knowledge and practical exposure, ensuring that learners acquire both intellectual depth and real-world skills. A unique credit-based system is followed, allowing flexibility in choosing courses and enabling seamless mobility across institutions.

Multidisciplinary Approach: The college adopts a multidisciplinary approach that encourages students to explore a wide range of disciplines such as Science, Humanities, Commerce, Social Sciences, Languages, and Vocational Studies. This model allows for both interdisciplinary (across broad domains) and intradisciplinary (within a field) combinations, offering students the freedom to shape their educational journeys according to their passions and career aspirations. The programme structure also supports mobility—both academic and geographical—through transfer of credits between institutions, encouraging lifelong learning and broader exposure.

Major Objectives of the Programme: The programme aims to uphold the spirit of multiculturalism and multilingualism, as emphasized by NEP 2020. By incorporating culture-based education and art-integrated learning, students are provided with diverse ways of



expressing their ideas and understanding complex concepts. The curriculum includes experiential learning components such as hands-on training, simulations, fieldwork, and real-life problem-solving. A major thrust is given to vocational training and skill-based courses to prepare students for emerging job markets and entrepreneurship. Additionally, the curriculum draws on discipline-specific information knowledge systems, reinforcing contextually relevant learning rooted in local and global contexts.

Programme Structure, Eligibility, and Duration: The undergraduate programme is spread over six semesters, with each semester comprising at least 90 working days. Students are expected to earn a minimum of 20 credits per semester, with opportunities to acquire additional credits through internships, research projects, and value-added courses. In the initial years, foundational and skill-enhancement courses are offered, followed by specialized courses in the major and minor disciplines. The eligibility for enrolling in undergraduate programmes is successful completion of the 10+2 level (HSC or equivalent) from a recognized board, with additional criteria for vocational/professional streams as per UGC norms.

Major and Minor Subjects with Electives: Students must select a Major Subject (12 credits per semester), which forms the core of their academic focus. This includes theoretical studies, practicals, internships, and a research project, particularly in the case of 4-year honours programmes. Alongside, students opt for a Minor Subject (6 credits per semester), which allows exploration of a different area of interest or a skill-oriented course. The inclusion of Open Electives (OEs) provides additional flexibility to pursue interdisciplinary knowledge.

Structure, Eligibility, and Duration of the Programme

Semester Credits:

- A semester consists of 90 working days, and students must earn a minimum of 20 credits per semester.
- Vocational and skill-enhancement courses are introduced during the initial years of study.
- Students will choose a Major and Minor subject, along with Open Electives (OEs).
- The programme is spread across six semesters.
- Students can earn extra credits by doing projects, internships, or value-added courses.

Major (Core) Subject Accompanied by Mandatory and Elective Courses

(A) Major Subject (12 Credits):

- The Major subject is the core area of study selected by the student.
- Includes theoretical and practical components.
- Research Project and Internship may be connected with the Major subject.



(B) Minor Subject (6 Credits):

- The Minor subject is a secondary area of interest.
- Students can choose from other disciplines or skill-based courses.

Value-Added Courses (VAC)

1. Understanding India

This course aims to enable students to acquire and demonstrate knowledge and understanding of contemporary India, framed within its historical perspective. It highlights:

- The basic framework of constitutional values and fundamental obligations.
- The roles and obligations of student-teachers and Indian educators to society and the nation.

The course emphasizes:

- Constitutional values and duties.
- Understanding Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS), Indian education systems, and the role of teachers in nation-building.
- Awareness of India's freedom struggle and its value systems.
- Cultivating an appreciation of contributions by diverse communities and regions of India.
- Understanding the Indian Constitution and preparing students for democratic responsibilities.

2. Environmental Science / Education

This course equips students with:

- Knowledge, skills, and attitudes to mitigate environmental degradation.
- Insight into climate change, pollution, waste management, conservation of biological diversity, and ecosystem services.



The course focuses on:

- Management of biological resources.
- Forest and wildlife conservation.
- Sustainable development and living.

It helps learners to:

- Understand India's environment in its entirety.
- Explore its interactive processes and effects on human life.
- Build sustainable and informed habits for the future.

3. Digital and Technological Solutions

This course introduces students to:

- Emerging technologies like Artificial Intelligence (AI), 3D Machining, Big Data, Machine Learning (ML), and Deep Learning.
- Their applications in education, health, and sustainability.

These are integrated into undergraduate education to:

- Enhance employability.
- Encourage innovation and digital awareness among youth.

4. Health & Wellness, Yoga Education, Sports, and Fitness

This component promotes:

- Holistic health—physical, emotional, intellectual, social, spiritual, and environmental.
- Yoga education to prepare students physically and mentally, integrating body, mind, and spirit.
- Personality development, discipline, and emotional self-regulation.

Sports and Fitness:

- Emphasizes physical fitness (strength, speed, endurance, coordination, flexibility).
- Develops motor skills, tactical thinking, and mental resilience.
- Focuses on acquiring sports-related and basic movement skills.

Research Project / Dissertation

- Required for students in a 4-year Honours with Research programme.
- Mentored by faculty members.
- Research project starts in the 8th semester.
- Outcomes may be published in peer-reviewed journals or presented in conferences/seminars, and may also be patented.

- National Cadet Corps (NCC)

Curricular Structure of Undergraduate Courses: The college offers a broad, interdisciplinary curriculum structured around a choice-based credit system, aiming to foster holistic development among learners. This approach includes a blend of major and minor subjects along with skill enhancement and value-added components.

Each course has a 4-credit evaluation: 3 credits assigned for theory and 1 credit for practical/tutorial/project work. In a semester of 15–16 weeks, 1 credit is equivalent to 1 hour/week for theory and 2 hours/week for practical. Overall, a student is expected to earn 160 credits for a 4-year UG Honours with Research degree, or 120 credits for a 3-year UG degree.

Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) and Flexibility in Completion: Students may opt to exit the programme after any academic year with the qualification earned at that point. Credit transfer and accumulation will be maintained through the Academic Bank of Credits, allowing flexibility in course completion and mobility between institutions.

Types of Courses Offered

- 1. Major Discipline**
Students must choose a major subject which runs throughout the duration of the programme. The major includes 50% of total credits and builds depth of knowledge in the chosen field.
- 2. Minor Discipline**
A student may choose one or more minor subjects from other disciplines. These allow the student to diversify their academic exposure.
- 3. Multidisciplinary Courses**
These courses enhance broad understanding across disciplines. Examples include courses on Indian Knowledge Systems, Environmental Education, Innovation and Entrepreneurship, etc.
- 4. Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC)**
These are designed to enhance language and communication skills. Students must study Modern Indian Languages (MIL) and English.
- 5. Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC)**
These courses promote skill development, employability, and entrepreneurship. Students



select from a variety of vocational and life-skill-based courses like Retail Management, Banking, Photography, Tourism, Communication Skills, and more.

6. Value-Added Courses (VAC)

These are offered to deepen understanding of national values, environmental science, digital innovation, and personal development. Examples include:

- Understanding India
- Environmental Science
- Digital and Technological Solutions
- Health & Wellness, Yoga Education, Sports and Fitness

7. Research Projects / Dissertation

For 4-year Honours students, a research project under faculty guidance is mandatory in the 8th semester. Outcomes may lead to publications or patents.

8. Internships/Field Projects

These are offered to provide practical and industrial exposure, mandatory for professional and vocational degree programmes.

Eligibility for UG Programmes

Candidates must have passed 10+2 (HSC or equivalent) from a recognized board to be eligible for UG programmes. Specific eligibility for vocational and professional programmes will be as per UGC or affiliating university guidelines.

Implementation of NEP 2020 in Postgraduate and Undergraduate Programs

In alignment with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, our institution **Anjuman Islam Janjira, Degree College of Science, Murud-Janjira**, has proactively undertaken curricular reforms to enhance academic quality and align with the broader objectives of flexibility, interdisciplinarity, and outcome-based learning. The NEP 2020 framework has been systematically implemented across various academic programs in a phased manner.

At the postgraduate level, the NEP 2020-based curriculum was introduced in the Department of Botany and the Department of Chemistry starting from the academic year 2023–2024 for Part I students. Subsequently, the implementation has been extended to Part II students beginning from the academic year 2024–2025. These curricular changes include credit-based systems, skill enhancement courses, research components, and interdisciplinary electives, in accordance with the guidelines prescribed by the University of Mumbai and the Government of Maharashtra.

This marks a significant shift towards a more holistic and flexible undergraduate education structure, incorporating multidisciplinary options, Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC), Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC), and value-added components as recommended under the NEP framework.

Anjuman Islam Janjira, Degree College of Science, Murud-Janjira, is committed to the full-scale implementation of NEP 2020 across all years and programs. Accordingly, the revised curriculum will be extended to the Second- and Third-Year undergraduate levels in subsequent academic years as per the academic calendar and regulatory framework prescribed by the affiliating university and statutory bodies.

This phased implementation underscores the institution's dedication to academic innovation and quality enhancement, thereby fostering student-centric, inclusive, and globally competitive higher education.

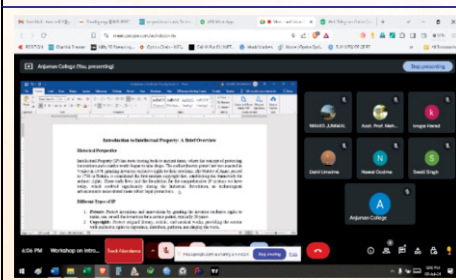

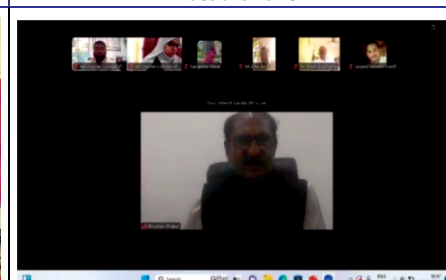

Rules of Discipline and Code of Conduct for Learners / विद्यार्थ्यांसाठी शिस्तीचे नियम व आचारसंहिता

I. Attendance

- Attendance at all lectures / practical's / tutorials / tests / assignments / examinations is compulsory for all courses. A learner, who is not regular in attendance or fails to carry out his/her work to the satisfaction of the Principal, is liable to cancellation of his/her terms.
- The learner who do not have minimum required attendance of 75% of actual lectures / practical's conducted in each semester or do not show satisfactory progress in semester/internal examinations will not be sent for college/University examinations.
- Periodical tests/assignments/seminars are compulsory for the learner of all classes.
- A learner who remains absent for the periodical test/assignment/examination due to his/her illness shall be required to submit the medical certificate, along with the application endorsed by parent.
- A learner who remains absent for three consecutive days is required to submit a leave application duly signed by his/her parent/guardian
- Learners who are not permitted for the University Examination will not be re-admitted to the college.

II. Instructions to Candidates about Examinations

- Be in time. A candidate who is late by more than 30 minutes shall not be admitted to the examination hall.
- No candidate shall be permitted to leave until half an hour is over after the question papers have been distributed.
- Enter on the title page the class, subject, section and seat number.
- Write on both sides of the page, unless instructed. Rough work should be written on the left hand side or on a separate page. Answer each question on a new page and number it.
- No pages shall be torn off from the answer-book given to the candidate.
- Nothing shall be written on the question paper.
- Exchange of written materials, stencils, mathematical instruments, etc is strictly prohibited. Ask the supervisor in case any thing is needed but do not leave the seat on any account, at any time do not leave the Examination Hall during the last ten minutes.
- A candidate is liable to disciplinary action for use of unfair-means e.g. if he/she
- Keeps with him/her any book, notes or any other written material.
- Speaks to or communicates, in any other way with another candidate
- Disobey any instructions issued by the senior or junior supervisor or is guilty of rude or diomedeid behavior.
- Any use of unfair-means during the examination is liable to severe penalties as per the ordinance.
- Ten minutes before the close, a warning bell will be rung, after which no candidate will be permitted to leave the hall. At the second bell, all must stop writing and be ready to handover the answer booklets to the supervisor.

III. Discipline

- Learners should always wear their valid college Identity card whenever in the college of should be produced whenever demanded by any of the college staff. No learner is allowed to enter in the college premises without valid identity card.
- In case of the any problem, personal or academic, learners should report to the respective class teacher of faculty incharge or the Principal who will help them to solve their problems.



- Every learner is responsible to the college and should take utmost care of the college premises/property. Any damage done to the property of the college is to be compensated either individually or collectively.
- Any damage to the college building, furniture and fixtures by the learners shall be treated as breach of discipline.
- Learners are advised to take care of gardens, plants, flowers, etc
- Learners should observe good punctuality Appropriate action will be taken against late comers.
- No committee or organization of learners is permitted in the college.
- Learners will not be allowed to bring any outsider with them in the college but in special case parents or any outsider may be allowed with prior permission and valid reason and entering the name on the gate register.
- No person, other than college staff, can be invited to address any meeting or to participate in the college activity without prior permission of the Principal.
- Learners are not supposed to loiter in the college corridors of college premises.
- Learners are expected to be seated in their respective classrooms at the stroke of the first bell and wait for the teacher. Learners are to make use of the library/reading rooms during free periods.
- Smoking is strictly prohibited in the college premises.
- If the conduct of any learner is detrimental to the college, the Principal may ask the learner to leave the college without assigning any reason. The Principal's decision is final in this regard.
- No learner shall collect any money without the written permission of the Principal.
- Discipline and good behavior are expected from the learners at all social gatherings and celebrations at the college.
- No notice shall be put on the notice boards, including black boards without the written permission of the Principal or the faculty members authorized in the matter concerned.
- Learners shall not organize picnics, excursion trips, etc., on their own, without the written permission of the Principal
- All activities, meetings, gatherings, picnics, hiking, etc., will be organized only with prior written permission of the Principal.
- The powers relating to the disciplinary action in the college will with the Principal and his decision in this respect shall be final. Any one who violates the code of conduct will be severely dealt with.
- Learners are not allowed to make complaints in a body or present any collective petition, but they are welcome to present their case, if any, individually.
- All the circulars, notices related to examinations and other programmes/activities, etc. are displayed on the college notice board. Concerned learners will be held responsible for the loss, if they failed to read the notices.

IV. Behavior and Conduct

- Learners are prohibited from doing anything inside of outside the college that will interfere in college administration or affects its public image. No outside influence, political or any other should be brought into the college, directly or indirectly
- Courtesy and respect must be the key aspects of learners' behavior Disrespect and disobedience may result in disciplinary action, involving suspension or even expulsion.
- When the teacher enters the classroom the learner must rise, remain standing still they are directed to down. When the attendance roll is called, each one must rise and give the presentee.
- Learners are expected to greet all visitors and members of the staff with respect. They should always remember that the college is judged by their conduct. Any major breach of discipline and courtesy and also disrespect for the members of the college staff will be treated as serious and responsible learners for such misbehavior will be summarily dismissed.
- Scribbling on the walls, desks, etc, should be avoided. If any learner is found scribbling the walls/desk disciplinary action shall be taken against him I her.



- All learners are responsible to the college authorities for their behavior both in and outside the college both Individually and collectively. Any reported or observed objectionable conduct outside the college on the part of the learners shall render them liable for disciplinary action.
- Congregating on the road in front of the college or at the entrance of the college creates a bad impression on the passers and therefore, is to be avoided.
- Learners are not expected to sit on the steps of the staircase or on the steps of the portico of the college.
- Learners have to park their vehicles at the parking shed only. Movement of vehicles in the college campus shall be in a moderate speed only.
- Throwing about waste papers, defacing the walls and committing nuisance on the college grounds are punishable offenses.
- Learners must not join any club or society or make any engagement that would interfere with their academic schedule, without the prior permission of the Principal.
- Learners are not allowed to play in any team against the official team of the college.
- Learners are forbidden to organize or attend any meeting within the college or collect money for any purpose from learners and outsiders or to circulate among the learners any notice or petition of any kind or paste it on the college notice board without the written permission of the Principal.
- The college is not responsible for loss of goods, valuables, money, etc. lost in college premises. It is advisable not to bring valuables to the college
- No books (other than text books or reference books or library books), magazines, etc. may be brought to the college.
- All should be particular about cleanliness of the college. They should use the baskets and bins specially provided for
- Habitual idleness, late coming, willful disobedience or misconduct, individually or collectively will be seriously dealt with.
- Learners suffering from diseases declared infectious by a Registered Medical Practitioner and which requires quarantine or segregation will not be permitted to attend the college without being certified as cured by the same Medical Practitioner
- Any learners who is persistency insubordinate or is repeatedly or willfully mischievous or is guilty of malpractices in connection with examinations or has committed an act of serious indiscipline and/or misbehavior, or who, in the opinion of the Principal has an unwholesome influence on his fellow learners may be suspended from the college for specified period or even expelled from the college.
- Insubordination and indecent language or conduct are sufficient reasons for the dismissal of the learners.
- Learners should switch off the lights, fans, etc. when not required and also while leaving the classrooms/laboratories/library.
- Learners should make themselves familiar with the college rules and regulations concerning them and also with the regulations and notices issued by the college from time to time.
- Learners joining the college are, by that very fact, deemed to accept and observe all the rules and regulations of the college to the entire satisfactions of the college authorities.

V. Mobile Phone

- Bringing of mobiles within the campus is strictly prohibited as per the University norms. If any learner found using a mobile, the mobile set shall be forfeited and strict action shall be taken against the learner.



VI. Dress Code

- All the learners are expected to observe decorum to enhance the image of the college.
- **T**-shirts without caller or having any pictures or slogans and multi-pocket trousers or pants are strictly not allowed.
- Parents are advised to take the note of observance of decency in dress of their wards.

VII. Ragging is Prohibited

- Government of Maharashtra has notified ragging as a cognizable offence Anyone reported to be involved in any form of ragging will be severely dealt with. Therefore learners are advised to restrain from indulging in any form of ragging.
- We have committed to observe the provisions of UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions 2009(Reference No. F1-16/2007 (CPP) Apr, 2009).
- Anti-Ragging Mechan in the College: The college has strong anti-ragging mechanism with Anti - Ragging Committee. CCTV cameras at vital points, regular interactions and counselling, surprise inspection at cafeteria restroom, recreation rooms, toilets, etc. List of teaching and non-teaching staff with contact numbers, handling anti-ragging mechanism is communicated to the learners at the beginning of the academic year.

- **Anti-Ragging Warning**

Ragging is organizable offence under the law on par with rape and other atrocities against women and ill treatment towards persons belonging to SC/ST Ragging is strictly prohibited in the entire institution, including its department, constituent units, all its premises (including academic, residential, sports, canteen etc/) whether located within the campus or outside.

Students indulging in ragging other students will be punished as per 'The Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1999 (Mah 30001 of 1999, Published in Maharashtra Govt. Gazette on 15 May 1999.

In pursuance to the judgement of the Hon'ble supreme court of India dated 08.05.2009 in Civil Appeal No 887/2009, the University Grants Commission has framed "UGC Regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions, 2009" which have been notified on 4 July 2009 in the Gazette of India.

Administrative Actions in the event of Ragging:

The institution shall punish students found guilty of ragging after following the procedure and the manner prescribed herein under:



- The Anti-Ragging Committee of the institution shall take an appropriate decision, in to punishment of otherwise, depending on the facts of each incident of ragging and nature and gravity of the incident of ragging established in the recommendation of the Anti-Ragging squad.
- The Anti-Ragging Committee may, depending upon the nature and gravity of the guilt established by the Anti-Ragging Squad, award, to those found guilty, one or more of the following punishments namely,
 - Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
 - Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
 - Debarring from appearing in any test, examination or other evaluation process.
 - Withholding results
 - Debarring from representing the institution in any regional/national or international meet tournament, youth festival, etc.
 - Cancellation of admission.
 - Rustication from the institution for period of ragging from one to four semester,
 - Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period.

Provided that where the person committing or abetting the act of ragging are not identified, the institution wall resort to collective punishment

VIII. Prohibition of sale of Cigarettes or Tobacco Products

Section 6 of the cigarettes and other Tobacco Products (Prohibition of Advertisement and Regulation of Trade and Commerce, Production, Supply and Distribution) Act, 2003 Provides that no person shall sell offer for sale or permit sale of cigarettes or any other Tobacco Product

- To any person who is under eighteen years of age.
- in an area within a radius of 100 yards of any educational institute

Sale of Cigarettes and other Tobacco products, in an area within a radius of 100 yards of an educational institute is strictly prohibited and is a punishable offence under Section 24 of the Act with a fine which may extend up to 200 Rupees

IX. Grievance Redressal of Learners

Grievance of learners are redressed systematically in the college through structured mechanism created by the Principal. The redressal mechanism is as under

- **Grievance Redressal Committee**

The college has constituted Grievance Redressal Committee to handle the grievances of the learners. The committee is headed by the Principal and Senior faculty members from each faculty as members. The one lady faculty member is also the member of the committee. Learners are advised to contact the Chairman, Grievance Redressal Committee to redress their grievances. Detail guidelines are available on college website.

- **Suggestion Boxes**

Suggestion boxes are kept at strategic places. The Grievance Redressal Committee under the guidance of the Principal scrutinizes the suggestions of the learners. Important suggestions are immediately taken into consideration for betterment of learner and development of the college. Learners are advised to put the valid suggestions in the suggestion boxes to resolve their grievances.



Rules of Attendance / उपस्थितीचे नियम

(Extract of Ordinance O.6086 of University of Mumbai)

1. Mandatory Average Attendance and Minimum Attendance for each Course

a) Every bonafide learner shall ordinarily be allowed to keep terms for the given semester in a programme of his/her enrolment, only if he/she fulfils at least seventy five percent (75%) of the attendance taken as an average of the total number of lectures, practices tutorials etc. wherein short and/or long excursions /field visits/study tours organized by the college and supervised by the teachers as envisaged in the syllabus shall be credited to his attendance for the total number of periods which are otherwise delivered on the material day/s.

b) Further it is mandatory for every learner to have minimum 50% attendance for each course and average attendance has to be 75%.

2. Consideration of Absentee on Account of Participation in Curricular/ Co-curricular/ Extra-curricular and Extension Activities with the Permission of the Principal

The above same ratio shall be applied for computing the attendance of the learner by crediting the number of periods which are missed while participating in an extra-curricular/ co-curricular / extension /activity/competition/camp/workshop/convention/symposium/seminar etc. where the said learner is officially representing the College/University/District/State/Country with the permission of the Principal wherein for the purpose of computing the average attendance the periods missed for what is envisaged here-in-above, at Sr No 1, shall be deemed to have been attended by the said learner.

3. Condonation of Additional 25% Absentee in Special Cases on Valid Evidence with the Permission of the Principal

Without prejudice to what is stated here-in-above, the Principal shall be the competent authority to condone the absentee of any learner further up to additional 25%, if deemed fit and on recommendation of the Attendance Committee of the wherein it is mandatory on the said committee to do natural justice by giving personal hearing to every learner falling short of minimum attendance for keeping terms and recommending case by case to the principal having verified the genuineness and gravity of the problem that justifies the learner to remain absent, which generally shall be limited to his own sickness, sickness of his/her parent, death of his/her parent, etc. supported by valid evidence, documentary or otherwise.

General Rules Pertaining to Attendance / उपस्थितीचे संबंधित नियम

1. Learners who request leave of absence from lectures/ practical's /tutorials for participating in sports, cultural, Avishkar research convention or any other curricular/co-curricular/extra-curricular/extension activities /competitions on behalf of the college should submit the application countersigned by the respective teacher incharge.

2. All decisions pertaining to recommend to grant of terms will be decided by an Attendance Committee duly constituted by the college.

in Case of Malpractices****गैरव्यवहारांच्या प्रकरणात
चौकशीची प्रक्रिया**

1. The candidate may be served a show cause notice and made aware of the charges/allegations reported against him to prepare his/her defense at the time of his/her appearance before the unfair Means Inquiry Committee and informing him/her thereby of the proposed action to be taken in his/her case with a request to reply to the show cause notice as to why the action proposed under it should not be taken against him/her.
2. The reply received by the Committee from the candidate when he/she appears before it, will considered by the committee and the final recommendation in the matter be made.
3. The punishment finally awarded can be equal to or less than what is mentioned in the show cause notice, but not more than what is mentioned therein.
4. The College Unfair Means Inquiry Committee is a recommendatory body. The principal has to exercise his/her power.

The broad categories of unfair means resorted by students at the University/ College/ Institution examinations and the quantum of punishment for each category thereof.

General Information

- The college has well equipped and fully computerized Central Library. It is open to all the learners having a Valid College Identity Card. The Library remains open between 08:00am to 04:00p.m. and Reading Halls are kept open overnight throughout the year OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue available for learners. They can retrieve the information such as author, title and subject indices.
- Additional Borrower Card are issued to 3 merit holders from each class to promote excellence.
- Apart from regular facilities additional literature is provided to the learners doing projects and learners participating in various competitions.
- Alumni are allowed to use Library facilities after obtaining Alumni Membership Card.
- Library Committee looks after the smooth conduct of Library management such as budgeting, purchase of books, etc.
- 'Best Reader Award' is given to the learners to promote excellence in reading.

Rules
