The papers can be submitted in English with Times New Roman font or in Hindi with Mangal Devanagari font. The abstract should not exceed 250 words including the key

words. The full paper (not exceeding 8 pages) is to be submitted after the acceptance of the abstract. The papers be typed using Times New Roman with font size of 12 in a single line spaced format. The Title should be in bold and sub-titles, sub-sub-titles thereafter should be in italic style with appropriate numberings. The tables, figures, charts and photographs must be clear and reproducible. The full paper including abstract must be typed in A4 size format and be submitted in Microsoft word format along with the PDF formats. All the responsibility of the contents and significance of paper contents will be of the authors. For more details, authors may follow the standard instructions which are generally followed for submission of Indian Journals. All the communications should be through e-mail only; no other mode of communication will be accepted. The detailed schedule of the conference will be communicated.
