## Teachers: Feedback Analysis Report Year 2018-19

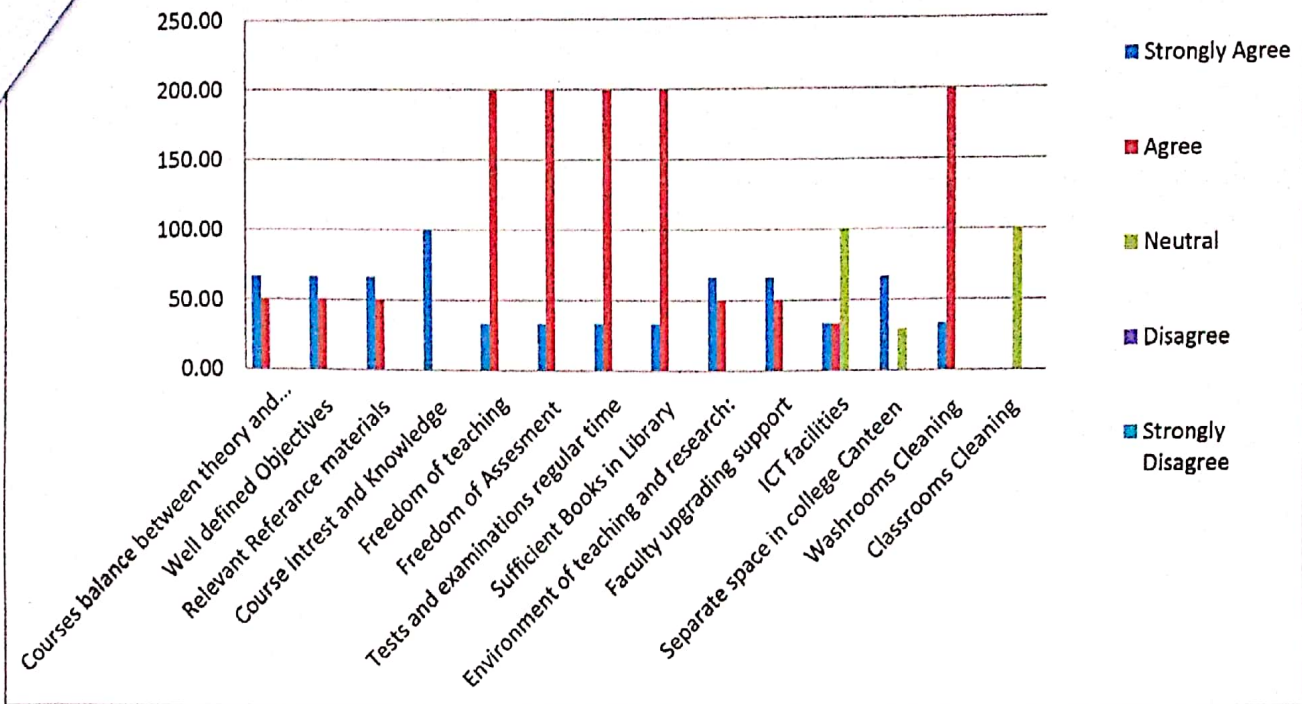

The teachers' feedback analysis for the academic year 2018-2019 reflects positive sentiments across various aspects of the educational environment. The feedback also indicated unanimous agreement on the students' interest and knowledge acquisition in the courses. However, a lower percentage of agreement was observed concerning the freedom of teaching, assessment, and timely conduct of tests and examinations.




