2. Organization of Free Medical Checkup Camp in collaboration with JSW Sanjivani Multi Specialist Hospital

To make basic healthcare accessible for such peoples, this institute in association with JSW Sanjivani Multi Speciality Hospital, Dolvi organized free health checkup camp. Many of these villages have no healthcare facilities or even a qualified healthcare worker. Volunteers from the institute work hard for awareness of such camp amongst the peoples of the society. The team of Specialist Doctors, Consultants, Nurses and Paramedics was present during camp to examined &

screened free of cost under privileged patients. The services that were provided at the medical camp were as follows:

More than 500 peoples attended the Free Mega Health Camp conducted on 28th May 2022. In addition to this, free Blood Pressure, Blood Sugar ECG Checkup was done.

3. Organization of Free Eye Checkup Camp & Cataract Operation Camp in collaboration with R. Jhunjhunwala Shankara Eye Hospital, New Panvel

This institute also looking for basic healthcare of peoples of the under privileged sector of society. To make basic healthcare accessible for such peoples, this institute in association with R. Jhunjhunwala Shankara Eye Hospital, New Panvel organized Free Eye Checkup Camp & Cataract Operation Camp. Many of these villages have no healthcare facilities or even a qualified healthcare worker. Volunteers from the institute work hard for awareness of such camp amongst the peoples of the society. The team of Specialist Doctors, Consultants, Nurses and Paramedics was present during camp to examined & screened free of cost under privileged patients.

More than 240 peoples attended the Free Eye Checkup Camp & Cataract Operation Camp conducted on 22nd February 2023. During this camp 30-40 patients detected cataract. These peoples are operated at free of cost. In addition to this, spectacles for needy peoples are made available in cheapest cost.

4. Organization of Hemoglobin & Dental Checkup camp

Women development cell in association with NSS & DLLE organized Hemoglobin & Dental checkup camp for girl's students. For this camp help is taken from Government Rural Hospital, Murud-Janjira.

5. POSHAN MAAH Campaign

'Rashtriya Poshan Maah' is celebrated each year in September with the aim to create awareness about nutrition and healthy food. This institute taken initiative for the organization of Poshan Maah campaign in association with Government Rural Hospital, Murud-Janjira for students of the schools and womens of the Murud taluka. This institute also put efforts for awareness about nutritional values of different foods. This institute organizes Poshan Maah campaign from 21st to 29th September 2022.

6. Sanitary Napkins Distribution to Tribal Women's (Adiwasi Women's) of Vihoor Village on occasion of International Women's Day

This institute always take care every pillar of society. Amongst all pillars Tribal community is less aware about the health & hygiene as well as personal safety. On

the occasion of International Women's day, women development cell of this institute plan to organize Sanitary Napkins Distribution to Tribal Women's (Adiwasi Women's) of Vihoor Village.

7. Certificates preparation & distribution from Revenue Department (Tehsil office)

NSS & DLLE students of this college render help to needy peoples for preparing different certificates such as domicile, income, cast certificate etc. from revenue department Murud Janjira Tehsil office. This college organized camp on 21st July 2022. Near about 60 peoples beneficated through this camp.

8. Education Material distribution to Mahad Flood affected school students

A series of floods took place across the Indian State of Maharashtra in 2021. Heavy rains and flooding in Mahad tehsil of Maharashtra's Raigad district in July had left 94 houses completely destroyed and 9,649 others damaged. Mahad was among the regions worst-affected by the floods that ravaged western Maharashtra on 22nd July 2021. For safety and security purpose Police, NGOs, social workers and government departments played vital role along with medical frontline workers. At the same time student & staff of this institute contributed the amount to provide stationary materials to school students of Mahad Nagarparishad.

9. Warmth donation- Blanket donation to tribal's

The tribal people in Murud Taluka are known as Katkari. They are tribes. They have hardly any daily commodities to survive. To donate blanket is practice carried out by Anjuman Islam Janjira Degree College of Science as a Best practice. It involved the student and staff. Each stakeholder was asked to donate certain amount as a voluntarily act. About Rs.27020/- amount was collected. The group of teacher and student lead the activity. The group purchase the 90 blankets from market. The college invited about 90 tribal's. College send public Rickshaw to bring them from their native to the college. Each of them were feed by college on their arrivals in campus. They were treated as 'guest' in college. With honored hospitality function was carried out and buy best handoff dignitaries, the blanket was given with love and humanity feelings. Each of tribal with blanket feels warmth off human touch almost each of them brush to tears for love affection and war tribal were treated as human, treated as honor guest and ask to visit to college as and when needs.

10. Donation in Disaster- Flood hit region

In June, July of 2019, it was heavy - Too heavy pondering of black clouds. It was heavy rain for number of days. Life was measurable in certain state and certain parts of district in our Maharashtra State. Once again the social call made positive impact. Almost every student in terms of parents, teaching and non-teaching staff contributed voluntary. The collection was made by concerned teacher and college represent that you students. The Rs. 14,000/- amount D.D./at par cheque was deposited to the State Bank of India, Murud Branch on date 11/09/2018. The remaining amount was approximately Rs. 15,000/-. This amount is used to purchase the educational material from local market. The educational material was stalked when and handed over to Hon. Snehalata Patil madam, President of Murud Municipal Council. It is because about the truck load material collection by society of Murud was supposed to process to Western Maharashtra. The contribution

collectively teaches that human values and humanity is important in critical situation of life. It is the “not me but you” social aspect.

The limited number of vaccination slots resulted in fewer administrations during the initial 5 months of the vaccination programme. The Government of India then amended the vaccination policy by waiving the preregistration requirement and offering free vaccinations to accelerate the programme. The COVID-19 vaccine drive in India was launched on 16th January 2021. From 1st May 2021, all people older than 18 years are eligible for the vaccination drive. This institute taken initiative for the organization of covid-19 vaccination camp in association with Government Rural Hospital, Murud-Janjira for students, staff & peoples of the society. This institute also put efforts for awareness about vaccination. This institute organizes vaccination camp in the month of October & November 2021.
